


Blue Christmas Worship December 21

Steps on the Journey

"It's beginning to look a lot like Christmas, everywhere you go." The old song rings true. It is beginning to look like Christmas especially if Christmas is about presents and getting stuff. This year it is estimated that we will spend more on Christmas presents than in any resonant year. I always find that interesting as a person of faith.

While the presents are nice, I find that celebrating God come down from heaven, in the form of Jesus, a tiny baby is a much more compelling reason to celebrate.

Think about it for a minute. There is a God who loves us so much that that God was willing to give up everything to come to earth so we might better understand how much someone would give up because they love us. God was willing to come to earth as a tiny, vulnerable baby to demonstrate for us how much we are loved.

I have in my office a picture of a young Palestinian woman holding a small child that someone gave to me years ago. Every time I look at the picture I am overwhelmed by the sacrifice my God was willing to make for me. Life was not easy. It was not a time of pleasure and comfort. But it was important to God that we have someone with skin on for us to understand what it means to be a person of faith and how one lives that kind of life, knowing it will cost their life.

So this Christmas think about the best present you will receive – God with us, Emmanuel, every step of the journey.



Emma Norton Services works with women, children, and families who are homeless and have the added challenges of mental illness, chemical dependency, or both. Safe and sober housing combined with programs and support services provide an environment where victory over homelessness, mental illness, and chemical dependency becomes a possibility.

Emma Norton Services began with one simple act of kindness almost a century ago by a group of women through the Methodist Church. It is through that same spirit of giving that Emma Norton Services is able to continue to provide the means and stability necessary for women, children and families to get healthy and get ahead.

We depend on your support to meet the basic needs of our residents and provide crucial services. Your help ensures the continuing operation of an organization that aids hundreds of women and children each year—women and children in dire need.

Some examples of your dollars at work:

- \$25 funds a welcome basket with necessary items like toiletries and feminine products for one woman \$40 provides healthy meals for one woman for one
- \$50 supplies bus passes to work, school, and support services for two weeks
- \$100 provides electricity and internet to Emma Norton Residence for one day
- \$250 covers 1.5 case managers to provide education, individual guidance, and life skills training
- \$500 funds a full year of afterschool sports, camps, and activities for 3 children at Emma's Place
- \$1000 provides nursing staff to care for women and families for one month

Youth Pizza & Movie




