Steps on the Journey

Sometimes it feels like Advent and Christmas come sooner every year. You turn, and it was autumn and then Halloween, then Thanksgiving and now we are getting ready for the next season – Advent, and then Christmas. Sometimes we want to skip over Advent and get to Christmas because that is when the fun is.

But this year take some time, pause and soak in Advent, that in-between time when we know what is going to happen but still it is not yet here. Sometimes that is how our life is— we know something is going to happen but we have to wait for it.

When I was younger I couldn't wait to turn 16 so I could get my driver's license. I couldn't wait to turn 18, so I could go to college and vote. I couldn't wait to be 21, to be considered an adult.

Today I am more content to wait and see what is going to happen. I have come to understand I may think I know the big picture but when I focus on that too much I miss the smaller things that God wants me to see. The moments of waiting allow me to see what God is up to. When I pause I am able to hear God's voice more clearly.

That is what Advent is for; waiting and watching because God is up to something here at Faith and in the larger world. We need to keep our eyes and ears open so we don't miss what God is doing in our lives, our congregation, our community and world.

We know God is coming – Emmanuel (God with us) but are we willing to be watching and waiting for what God has in store for us today.


